

Chinese Outbound Investment



THE BRIDGEHEAD FOR CHINESE OUTBOUND INVESTMENT

Chinese enterprises are increasingly looking to expand and upgrade themselves by taking up investment and partnership opportunities in overseas markets via Hong Kong, particularly in such sectors as advanced technologies, intellectual property and consumer brands. Hong Kong and the Chinese mainland are the largest investors in each other's economies, with almost 60 per cent of the mainland's cumulative outbound investment channelled to or through Hong Kong. The Hong Kong gateway includes:

- Full spectrum of world-class legal, financial and business services
- Low and simple tax system
- Independent legal system that protects intellectual property
- Liberal trade and investment regimes
- Familiarity with facilitating the business needs of Chinese investors





